- We use THERE ISN'T O THERE AREN'T para indicar lo que **NO HAY**

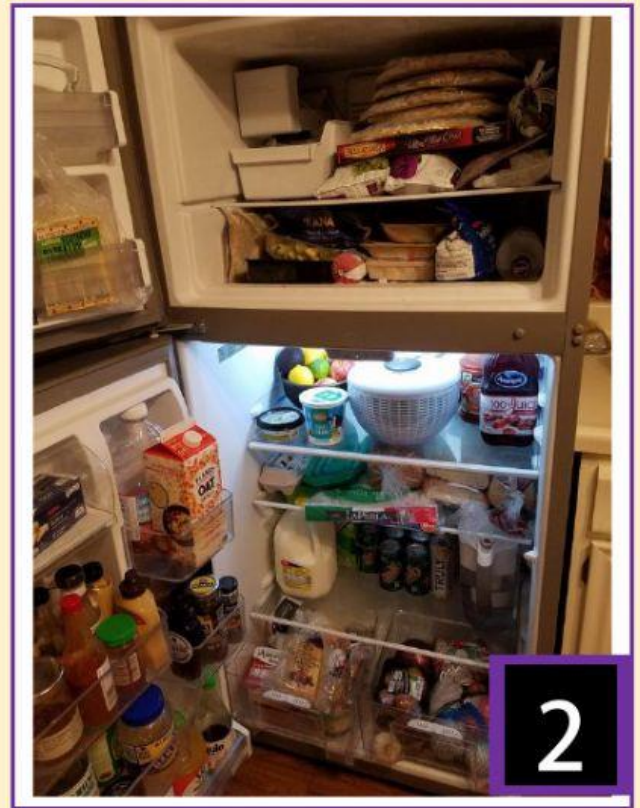
