

### Future – to be + going to + verb

Uses:	
<b>Plans and Intentions</b> (planes e intenciones)	Freddy <b>is going to buy</b> a new car next year.
<b>Predictions with evidence</b> (predicciones con evidencia)	Look at those clouds! It <b>is going to rain</b> .
Signal Words (palabras claves)	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Tonight</li> <li>• This afternoon, this weekend, etc...</li> </ul>

#### Affirmative

I	<b>am</b>

You	<b>aren't</b>

We	<b>aren't</b>		
They	<b>aren't</b>
