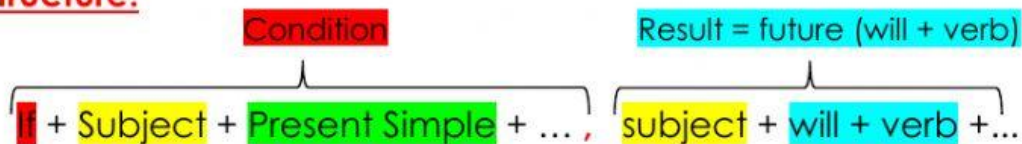


First Conditional

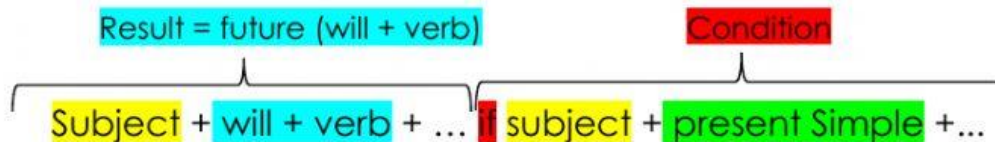
First Conditional is **used to:**

- Express a **real or very probable situation in the future**. It refers to things that will possibly happen in the future if a condition is met. (Expresa una situación real o muy probable en el futuro. Se refiere a cosas que posiblemente sucederán en el futuro si la condición se cumple.)
- It is common when we are talking about **possible plans, promises, warnings, threats**, or for **persuading** someone. (Es común cuando se habla de planes posibles, promesas, advertencias, amenazas o para convencer a alguien.)
