PASSING LANES:

- 1) BEFORE YOU PASS, LOOK AHEAD FOR ROAD CONDITIONS AND TRAFFIC THAT MAY CAUSE OTHER VEHICLES TO _____ INTO YOUR LANE.
- 2) NEVER DRIVE OFF THE PAVED OR MAIN TRAVELED _____ OF THE ROAD OR ON THE SHOULDER TO PASS.
- 3) THE EDGE OF THE MAIN TRAVELED PORTION OF THE ROAD MAY HAVE A PAINTED _____ LINE ON THE ROAD'S SURFACE.
- 4) PASSING OTHER VEHICLES AT CROSSROADS, RAILROAD CROSSINGS, AND SHOPPING CENTER ENTRANCES IS _____.
- 5) PASS TRAFFIC ON THE LEFT. YOU MAY PASS ON THE RIGHT ONLY WHEN:
 - AN OPEN _____ IS CLEARLY MARKED FOR TWO OR MORE LANES OF TRAVEL IN YOUR DIRECTION.
 - THE DRIVER AHEAD OF YOU IS TURNING LEFT AND YOU DO NOT DRIVE OFF THE _____ TO PASS. NEVER PASS ON THE LEFT IF THE DRIVER IS _____ A LEFT TURN.

CARPOOL/HIGH-OCCUPANCY VEHICLES (HOV) LANES

- 1) AN HOV LANE IS A _____ LANE USED ONLY FOR CARPOOLS, BUSES, MOTORCYCLES, OR DECALED LOW-EMISSION VEHICLES.
- 2) YOU MAY USE A CARPOOL/HOV LANE OR ON-RAMP IF YOUR VEHICLE CARRIES THE POSTED MINIMUM NUMBER OF PEOPLE REQUIRED FOR THE CARPOOL LANE, OR YOU DRIVE A LOW _____ OR A ZERO EMISSION VEHICLE DISPLAYING A SPECIAL DMV-ISSUED DECAL.
- 3) MOTORCYCLISTS MAY USE DESIGNATED _____/HOV LANES, UNLESS OTHERWISE POSTED.

4) SIGNS AT THE ON-RAMP OR ALONG THE _____ TELL YOU THE MINIMUM NUMBER OF PEOPLE PER VEHICLE REQUIRED FOR THE CARPOOL/HOV LANES.

5) THESE SIGNS ALSO LIST THE DAYS OF THE WEEK AND THE HOURS WHEN THE CARPOOL/HOV _____ APPLIES.

6) THE PAVEMENT IN THIS LANE IS MARKED WITH A _____ SYMBOL AND THE WORDS "CARPOOL LANE."

7) THESE LANES ARE ALSO _____ AS HOV LANES.

8) DO NOT CROSS OVER DOUBLE _____ SOLID LINES TO ENTER OR EXIT ANY CARPOOL/HOV LANE EXCEPT AT DESIGNATED ENTRY OR EXIT PLACES.
