I- Read this text by a 14-year-old English boy from Liverpool:

Hello! I'm Sam from Liverpool. Since the lockdown on the 23rd March, my life has changed a lot. My daily routine is not the same at all. Usually, I wake up at 7 because I have to take the bus to go to school. Now, I can get up at 8 because I stay at home and I just have my breakfast before starting my school work. Sometimes, I don't even get dressed! My teachers give me homework and I have to send many things to them so I usually spend 2 or 3 hours in the morning on my computer. I use my laptop or my tablet but the laptop is better if I have to type long things. The problem is that my older brother needs the computer too for his school work so we have to share it. I usually manage with my homework but I sometimes ask my mum to check. She stays at home because she is working from home so she spends her day on her computer and is often very busy. As for my dad, he still goes to work because he works in a supermarket. He always leaves the house with his face mask and his gloves and when he arrives home, the first thing he does is going to the bathroom to have a wash. At about 12.30, we have lunch, the 3 of us, then, we have a break and we go back to work at about 1.30. I do schoolwork during 2 or 3 hours, it depends on what the teachers give us. I usually stop at about 4.30 and I have a snack. I relax and try to have fun, I sometimes play football in the garden or listen to music on my bed. Before the lockdown, I used to spend 1 or 2 hours playing video games in the evening but now I spend many hours on my computer so I try not to play as much. Another thing that changed with the lockdown is that I chat much more with my friends because I miss them so much! In the past, I used to feel the need to be on my own whereas now I would like to be with my friends all the time. My dad comes back home at about 6 and we have dinner, the 4 of us, at 6.30. After dinner, we watch TV or play board games and then we go to bed and I chat with my friends.
