The graph shows the number of football goals scored by teams. Read the graph carefully to answer questions 13, 14 and 15.

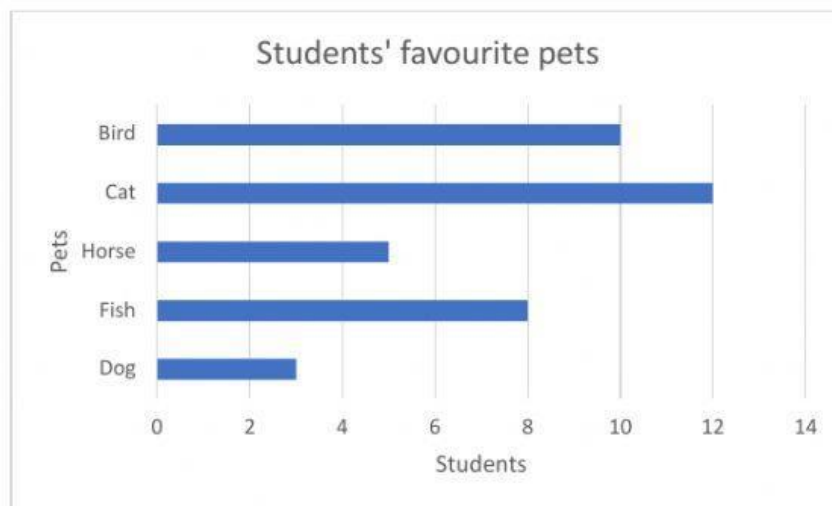
