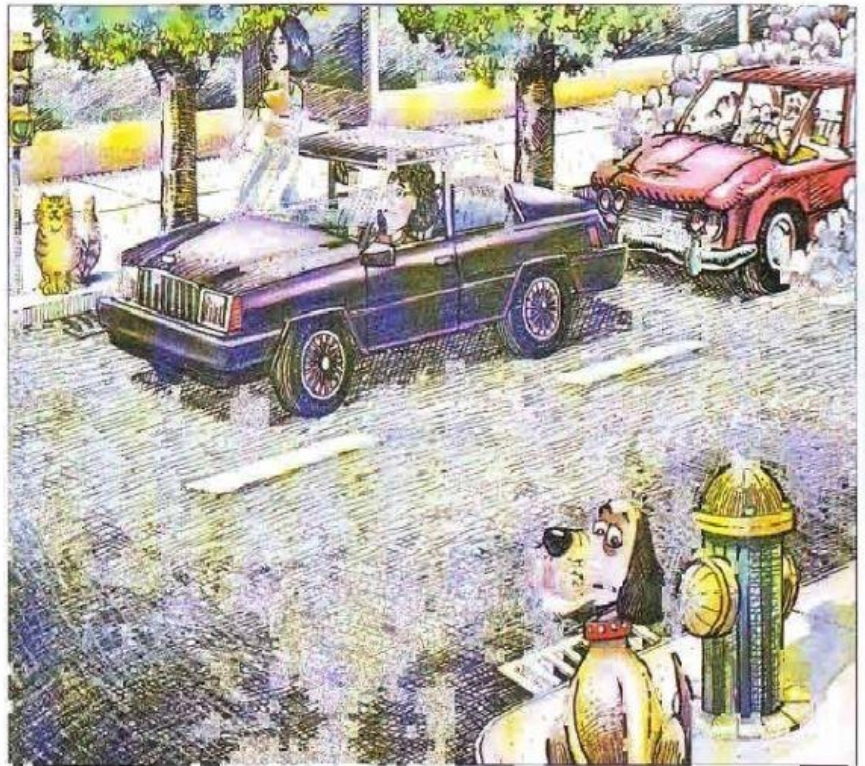
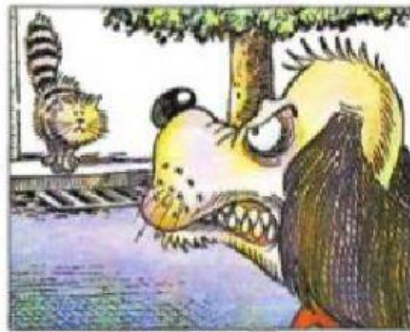


An accident

She quickly put her foot on the brakes.



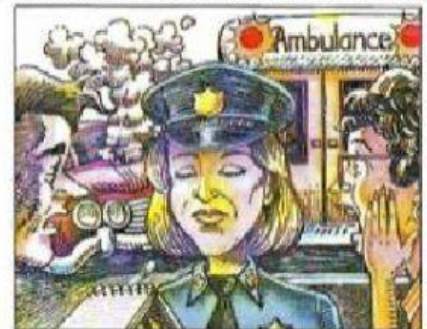
The Ford crashed into the Chevrolet.
