

Definitions bingo – geographical features

a) Drag the geographical features next to their definitions.

archipelago	<input type="text"/>	It's an area of land surrounded by water on all sides.
basin	<input type="text"/>	It's a group of islands.
bay	<input type="text"/>	It's a part of the coast which goes into the sea.
beach	<input type="text"/>	It's a small area of the sea partially enclosed by land.
cape	<input type="text"/>	It's a large area of the sea partially enclosed by land.
cliff	<input type="text"/>	It's a low, flat coastal area covered in sand.
glacier	<input type="text"/>	It's a very steep or vertical rock formation on a high coastal area.
gulf	<input type="text"/>	It's an area of land surrounded by water on all sides except one.
island	<input type="text"/>	It's a piece of land that connects a peninsula to a continent.
isthmus	<input type="text"/>	It's a low, flat area of land.
peninsula	<input type="text"/>	It's a natural depression, or low area of land, which can be below sea level.
plain	<input type="text"/>	It's a large, high, flat land area.

plateau



It's a high land with steep sides.

mountain



It's an area of low land between mountains, often with a river flowing along it.

valley



It's a river of ice that moves slowly down a mountain.

b) Choose 9 words and drag them into the grid to play the game.

archipelago	cliff	peninsula
basin	glacier	plain
bay	gulf	plateau
beach	isthmus	valley
cape	mountain	island

c) Listen to the clues in the order indicated by the numbers (no cheating!) Drag the words back to the red boxes when you hear them.
