Past simple vs Present perfect

The past simple is used for actions that finished in the past and have no connection to the present.
The present perfect is used for actions that haven't finished.

- My grandma never went to Madrid
- Paul has never been to Madrid

We use the simple past with past time expressions. This includes:

- I went there YESTERDAY - She told me TWO HOURS AGO - They went to London IN 2002

 - *Gerry always used to go for a run before breakfast.*
 - *Peter didn't use to say things like that when I knew him.*
- to refer to an activity or state that was true in the past but is no longer true.
 - *I used to like rock climbing when I was younger.*
 - *You didn't use to be so stressed!*
