(LA: with teacher guidance) (MA: read independently)



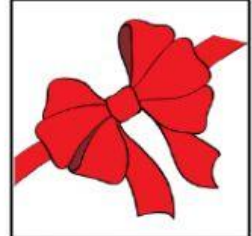
The girl's bow is red.

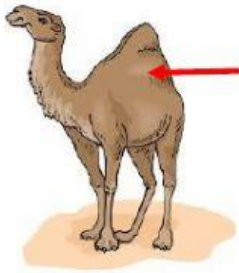


The boy's sock is wet.
