REVISION (NO COPIAR) POSSESSIONS (negative)

When we want to talk about things We don't
posses or have. We use the verb **HAVEN'T**
GOT or **HASN'T GOT**.



+ **HAVEN'T GOT**

HAVE NOT



+ **HASN'T GOT**

HAS NOT

I have got long brown hair.

I've got a pink mouth.

I've got two ears.

I HAVEN'T GOT blue eyes.

I HAVEN'T GOT big nose.

I HAVEN'T GOT red hair.

She has got long blue hair.

She's got a small nose.

She's got a head.

She HASN'T GOT big eyes.

She HASN'T GOT three noses.

She HASN'T GOT pink hair.

POSSESSIONS (questions)

When we want to ask about things a person posses or has. We use the verb **HAVE GOT** or **HAS GOT** in a question.



HAVE **you** GOT a dog?

YES, I HAVE.

HAVE **you** GOT a red car?

NO, I HAVEN'T.





HAS **she** GOT a brother?

YES, SHE HAS.



HAS **he** GOT a blue bike?

NO, HE HASN'T.



She is Carol.

Has she got a teddy bear?

Has she got a dog?

Has she got a robot?

Has she got a red car?

Has she got a beautiful cat?
