### THE FIRST WORLD CUP

The World Cup is the most famous football competition in the world. Every four years, thirty-two teams from all over the world compete for the famous gold cup. But do you know about the competition's history?

The first World Cup was in 1930. It was in Uruguay, in South America. The people of Uruguay were excited about the competition, and they built a new stadium in the country's capital. In the final, Uruguay played Argentina. More than 93,000 came to the stadium – there was no TV in those days. Uruguay won 4–2!
