## PRONUNCIATION OF REGULAR VERBS IN THE PAST (Pronunciación de los verbos regulares en pasado)

La terminaciones no siempre se pronuncian igual, hay 3 formas de pronunciar la terminación -ED: , y no depende de la ortografía, sino del sonido en que termina el verbo infinitivo.
