Tense	Uses	Affirmative	Negative	Interrogative
Past Simple	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- To describe completed actions and situations</li> <li>- Past time expressions: <i>yesterday, last night/week...</i></li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Most regular verbs: we add <b>-ed</b></li> <li>- Regular verbs ending <i>vowel + consonant + vowel</i>: we <b>double the consonant and add -ed</b></li> <li>- Regular verbs ending <i>-e</i>: we add <b>-d</b></li> <li>- Regular verbs ending <i>consonant + y</i>: we <b>remove -y and add -ied</b></li> <li><i>Irregular verbs have their own past</i></li> </ul>	<p>We use the past of the verb do in its negative form and the verb in infinitive <b>didn't + verb</b></p>	<p>We use the past of the verb do + subject + infinitive <b>Did you play...?</b></p>
