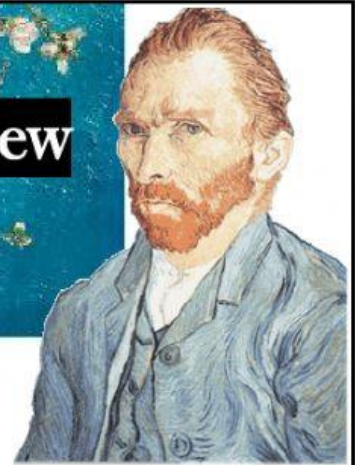




Vincent van Gogh: Overview

HOW MUCH DO YOU KNOW ABOUT VINCENT VAN GOGH?

Whilst in part this may be true, in reality his innovative and unique artistic style was of enormous importance to a host of artists who followed in his wake. 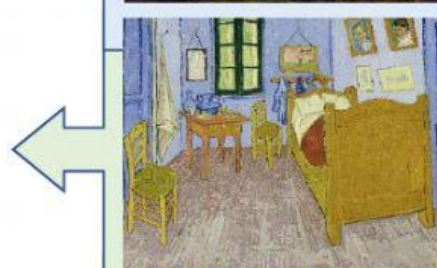
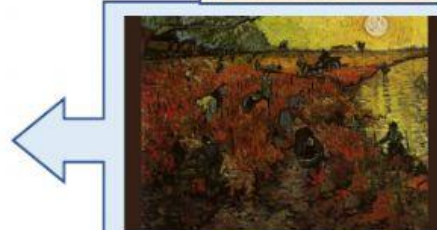
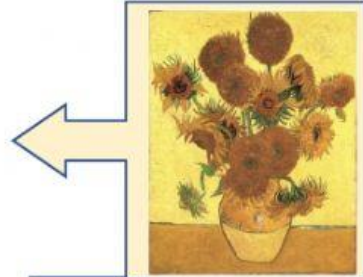
