He is one of most famous Egyptian pharaohs. His body was mummified because ancient Egyptians believed in the Afterlife. The Afterlife was important for them. Tut was buried with all treasures in a tomb in the Valley of the Kings. His people did not time in nine years to build a big tomb for him. They had to finish a tiny tomb quickly. There were four rooms inside the tomb, where archaeologists found lots treasures: a golden throne, a crown, a cobra and personal objects. Archaeologists also found a big golden mask Tut's sandals in the tomb. Tut's tomb was discovered 1922 by Howard Carter and Lord Carnarvon. Today, most of the treasures are exhibited at the Egyptian Museum El Cairo, Egypt.
