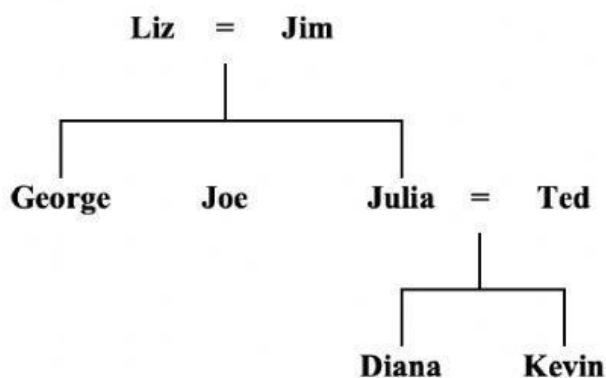
Singular Possessive adjectives
