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Declarative and Interrogative Sentences

A **declarative sentence** is a statement that tells something. A statement ends with a **period (.)**.

It is a very hot day.

An **interrogative sentence** is a sentence that asks something. It is a **question**. A question ends with a **question mark (?)**.

Put a **period** at the end if the sentence is a statement.

Put a **question mark** at the end if the sentence is a question.

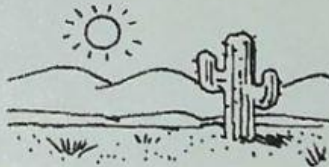
