FUTURE SIMPLE: WILL

Will predictions:

- ✓ We use **will** to talk about a future event, something that we think or predict will happen.
- ✓ We usually use the contractions **will (won't)** for a negative prediction.
- ✓ **Will/ Won't** we use the infinitive without to.
