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

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### Simple Past – Irregular Verbs

Do you remember? To form regular verbs in the past, we add **-ed** (*play-played; love-loved; want-wanted*) to the verbs.

However, **irregular verbs** are different and we can find them in a *List of Irregular Verbs* (Check the verb list on page 108).

These are some examples:

Infinitive	Past	Infinitive	Past
<i>be</i>	<i>was / were</i>	<i>know</i>	<i>knew</i>
<i>become</i>	<i>became</i>	<i>make</i>	<i>made</i>
<i>buy</i>	<i>bought</i>	<i>meet</i>	<i>met</i>
<i>fall</i>	<i>fell</i>	<i>say</i>	<i>said</i>
<i>go</i>	<i>went</i>	<i>spend</i>	<i>spent</i>
<i>have</i>	<i>had</i>	<i>take</i>	<i>took</i>
<i>hear</i>	<i>heard</i>	<i>write</i>	<i>wrote</i>

### Past Time Expressions

When we speak in the past, we often use time expressions such as:

*last year / last month / last week*  
*two days ago / three weeks ago*  
*yesterday*  
*the day before yesterday*  
*this morning*

*Two years ago, I visited New Zealand and I loved it!*  
*I saw Mrs Jones this morning.*  
*I went to the theatre yesterday.*
