## Regular Verbs

🕶 + past tense + adverb (time).

base form + d/ed (liked, baked, decided, baked, etc.) He baked the cake yesterday. (added, listened, whirred, etc.) He helped me yesterday.

#### **Adverbs of Time**

- yesterday
- last week
- 📥 last year
- when I was
- **two weeks ago**
- 📥 in September
- **4** in 2019

Don't add d/ed to the base form (wore, ate, slept, chose, bought, etc.) He bought the cake yesterday.
