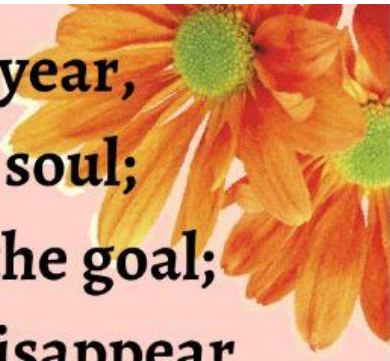

b. Pick out the alliterated words from the last line.



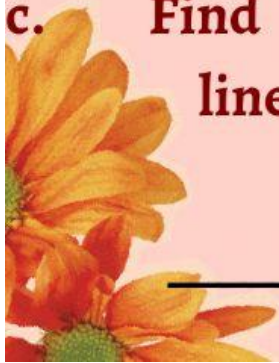


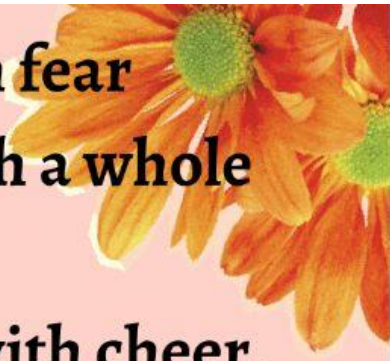
2. Let me but live my life from year to year,

c. Find out the Figure of Speech employed in the last two lines.



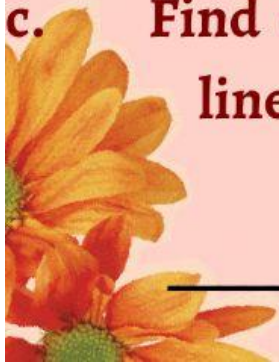


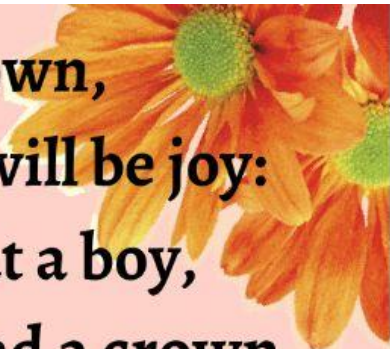
3. In the dim past, nor holding back in fear

c. Find out the Figure of Speech employed in the first line.



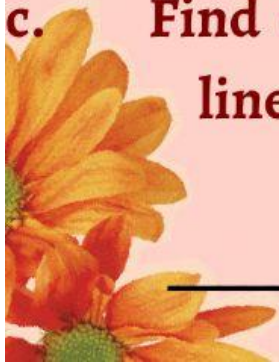

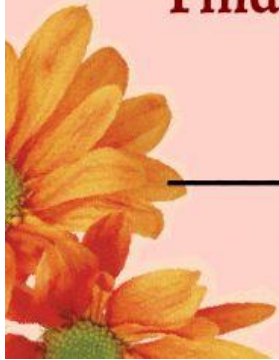
