



Simple Past

Affirmative

Subject + regular / irregular verb +

Examples: I WENT to the beach last summer

She PLAYED hockey last year.

Negative

Subject + DIDN'T / DID NOT + infinitive verb

Examples: I DIDN'T GO to the beach last summer

She DIDN'T PLAY hockey last year.

Interrogative

DID + Subject + infinitive verb + ... + ?

Examples: DID YOU GO to the beach last summer?

DID She PLAY hockey last year?

short answers

Yes, subject DID / No, subject + didn't

Examples: yes, I DID / No, I DIDN'T

Yes, she DID / No, she DIDN'T
