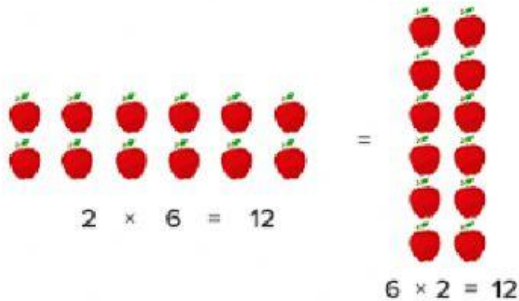


THE COMMUNITIVE PROPERTY OF MULTIPLICATION

What is the commutative property of multiplication: This is a method of multiplication that states you can multiply numbers in an equation in any order and still get the same answer.



EXAMPLE:

Commutative Property Match
