**RULE:** Use the past simple to talk about finished actions in the past.

**With regular verbs:**


- We usually add <sup>1</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ to the verb (e.g. *start – started / stay – stayed*).
- If the verb ends in -e (e.g. *use*), we add <sup>2</sup> \_\_\_\_\_.
- If a short verb ends in consonant + vowel + consonant (e.g. *plan*), we double the <sup>3</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ and add -ed.
- We add -ed to verbs ending in vowel + -y (e.g. *stayed*).
- If the verb ends in consonant + -y (e.g. *try*), we change the -y to <sup>4</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ and add <sup>5</sup> \_\_\_\_\_.
