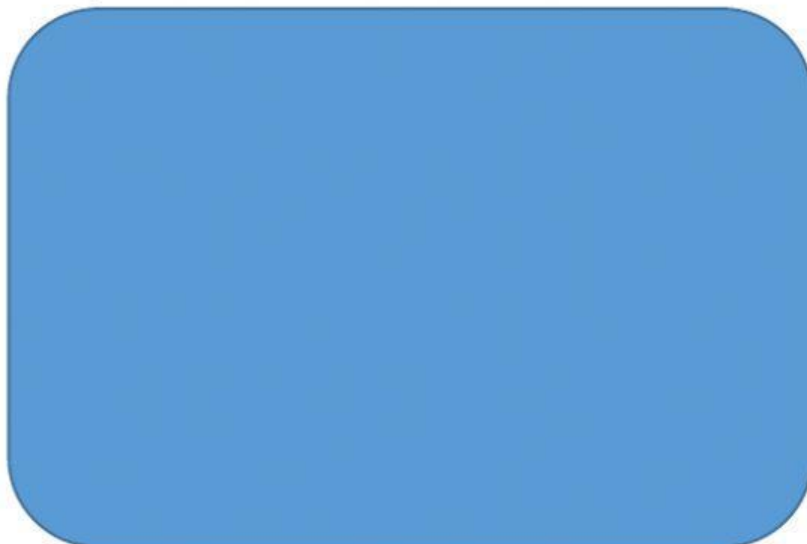
There is y **there are** son dos estructuras equivalentes a la forma del verbo haber en tiempo presente: hay.

La estructura de there is y there are

There is se utiliza con **nombres contables** en **singular** introducidos por los artículos indeterminados **a/an** o el número **one** y con **nombres incontables**. **There are** se utiliza con **nombres contables** en **plural**.

STRUCTURE		EXAMPLES
AFFIRMATIVE	Singular	There is a chair in my room. <i>Hay una silla en mi habitación.</i>
	Plural	There are a lot of birds in the sky. <i>Hay muchos pájaros en el cielo.</i>
NEGATIVE	Singular	There isn't a lift. <i>No hay ascensor.</i>
	Plural	There aren't dinosaurs in the world. <i>No hay dinosaurios en el mundo.</i>
INTERROGATIVE	Singular	Is there... ? <i>¿Hay algún lugar dónde pueda dejar mi maleta? Sí.</i>
	Plural	Are there... ? <i>¿Hay tiendas abiertas hoy? No.</i>
