Superlative adjectives

- When an adjective has got 1 syllable we add 'est'. e.g. *long* → *the longest*
deep → *the deepest*

NB if the adjective ends consonant + vowel + consonant, we double the final consonant e.g. *big* → *the biggest*

- When an adjective has got 2 syllables and ends in -y, we change the y to i e.g. *noisy* → *the noisiest*

- When an adjective has got 3 or more syllables we use *most* e.g. *venomous* → *the most venomous*
