how + adjective/adverb

- *How colorful these fish are!*
- *How well you swim!*

what + (a/an) + (adjective) + noun

- *What amazing scenery!*

so + adjective/adverb

- *It's so beautiful here!*

such + (a/an) + adjective + noun

- *This is such an exciting trip!*
