Affirmative

I/You/He/She/	listened.
It/We/They	danced.
	studied.
	travelled.

Negative

I/You/He/She/	didn't (did not) listen.
It/We/They	didn't (did not) dance.
	didn't (did not) study.
	didn't (did not) travel.
