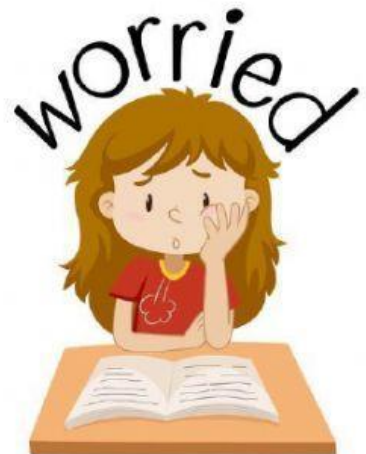
Select the character trait that best describes each situation.
