Changes at Work

Jobs have changed significantly because of the COVID-19 pandemic. These are the stories of Rosalinda and Felix, two hard-working people who have adapted quickly to changes in the workplace.

Time to Change! – Rosalinda



“WE NEED TO BE EXTRA CAREFUL WITH FOOD IN THESE TIMES.”

The COVID-19 pandemic has changed Rosalinda's life. Rosalinda was a street vendor who used to sell *anticuchos* in Lima, but now she has adapted her business to the new normal. Before the pandemic, her customers used to stay

at her food stand and eat there. She stills sells the *anticuchos*, but, now, the customers get the food to go.

Rosalinda's new normal

Rosalinda has been under lockdown because she is over sixty. At first she felt desperate, but she decided to adapt her business to the new normal. Now, her house is her new workplace. Rosalinda never used to ask for any help. Her son Martín is a university student, but now he helps her much more than before. Martín never used to go shopping for her, but now he goes to the local market every day. He doesn't want Rosalinda to get sick. Rosalinda misses her co-workers and friends. “Pochita used to sell *mazamorra*, José used to sell *churros* and Margarita used to sell popcorn. We used to help each other in the streets.”

Rosalinda says, with an expression of sadness on her face.

Delicious *anticuchos* in the south of Lima

Rosalinda's house is in Villa María del Triunfo. It is 20km away from the centre of Lima, but her customers go to Rosalinda's house. They come from different towns in Lima. Her *anticuchos* are famous in the city. Rosalinda says: “My customers never used to come to my home. I am happy when I see them.”

Rosalinda was always careful with the cookware she used, but now Rosalinda and Martín are even more careful than before. They disinfect everything and wash their hands with soap. They never used to wear a mask all the time, but now they do. “We need to be extra careful with food in these times.”, says Rosalinda.

New Normal, New Job! - Félix Soto



“THINGS HAVE CHANGED A LOT THIS YEAR, SO I HAD TO ADAPT AND CHANGE, TOO.”

During the lockdown, Félix's job changed too. Five months ago, he was a waiter in “Chifast” restaurant. He still works there, but now he is a delivery person. Before, customers ate in the restaurant and he used to love his job as a waiter. He used to take the food to the customers' tables. But now, he delivers food to the customers' homes on his bike.

Before the pandemic, he used to take the bus to go to the restaurant. He never used to ride a bike. But, now he rides his bike to work. He starts work at 11:00am and finishes at 7:00pm. He

delivers food all over the city. Félix misses his co-workers and customers, but there are also things he likes about his new job. For example, he loves riding his bike every day. “I never used to like sports. Riding a bike every day is like a sport to me.” Félix says, “Things have changed a lot this year, so I had to adapt and change, too.”
