

## Present continuous: affirmative, negative and interrogative.

### REMEMBER!

#### Remember the spelling rules!

- Verbs ending in **-e** drop the **-e**.  
*come* – *coming*
- Verbs with one syllable that end in a vowel and a consonant, double the consonant.  
*stop* – *stopping*
- Verbs ending in **-y** add **-ing**.  
*play* – *playing*  
*try* – *trying*
