REMEMBER!

Remember the spelling rules!

- Verbs ending in **-e** drop the **-e**.
come – coming
- Verbs with one syllable that end in a vowel and a consonant, double the consonant.
stop – stopping
- Verbs ending in **-y** add **-ing**.
play – playing
try – trying
