Frequency Adverbs

We use some adverbs to describe how frequently we do an activity. These are called adverbs of frequency. Let's look at the table given below (Bazı zarfların, bir eylemi hangi sıklıkta yaptığınızı anlatmak için kullanınız. Bu zarfları sıklık zarfları şeklinde adlandırınız. Frequency	Adverb of Frequency
100%	always
90%	usually
80%	normally / generally
70%	often / frequently
50%	sometimes
30%	occasionally
10%	seldom
5%	hardly ever / rarely
0%	never
