In the present simple third person (SHE/HE/IT) we add **-s/ -es/ -ies** to the verb in affirmative sentences.

ES

We add **-es** to verbs ending with:
CH / SH / S / O / X

GO → GOES

IES

When a verb ends with CONSONANT + Y, we change the Y by **-ies**:

FLY → FLIES


