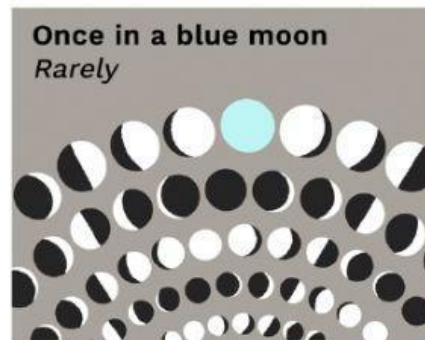




Idioms
