***Nonfiction**

- *Author tells real events about someone else's life, not their own
- *Readers learn facts about someone's life

Fiction story (usually long)

- *Often has talking animals
- *There's usually wizardry or magic

***Fiction story**

- *An animal is usually the main character
- *The story usually teaches a lesson

***Fiction Story**

- *a traditional story with a moral or lesson that has been handed down by people of a region from one generation to the next

***Fiction story**

- *Characters could include princesses, princes, kings, queens, wizards, witches, and giants.
- *most have happy endings

***Fiction Story**

- *Gods and Goddesses are characters
- *Explains how things came to be
- *Many stories originated in Greece

***Fiction story**

- *Uses lots of exaggeration
- *Character has qualities that humans can not have
- *Usually it is a silly story

***Fiction story set in the past, based on what life was really like**

- *Characters and events may be real or made up
- *Events teach readers what life was like at that time in history

***Fiction Story**

- *Events and setting could actually happen in real life even though the story is made up
- *Characters have real-life problems

***A story centered around a puzzling event**

- *usually something that has to be solved

***Nonfiction**

- *The author is also the narrator who tells a true story about their own life
- *There are true facts about the author's life
