



Grammar: Simple Past: Regular Verbs

To form the **simple past** of most **regular verbs** add **-ed**.

We sail in the lake. → We sailed in the lake.

To change some other verbs to the simple past, look at the endings.

live → **lived** cry → **cried** play → **played**
control → **controlled**

For negatives, use *did not* + the base form of a verb.

For Yes/No questions, use *Did* + subject + the base form of a verb.

For *Wh*- questions, use *Wh*- word + subject + the base form of a verb.
