

AND OR BUT SO BECAUSE



WE USE **AND** TO LINK WORDS THAT ARE SIMILAR

EXAMPLE: I'M GOING TO BUY VEGETABLES AND FRUIT.

WE USE **OR** TO TALK ABOUT CHOICES

EXAMPLE: WHAT DO YOU WANT TO EAT MEAT OR PASTA?

THE WORD **OR** IS OFTEN USED WITH NOT

EXAMPLE: SHE CAN'T SING OR DANCE.



WE USE **BUT** TO LINK WORDS THAT ARE DIFFERENT.

EXAMPLE: THE WEATHER WAS SUNNY BUT WINDY

WE USE **SO** TO TELL THE PURPOSE OF SOMETHING

EXAMPLE: I TAKE A MAP SO I WON'T GET LOST.

WE USE **BECAUSE** TO TELL WHY SOMEONE IS DOING SOMETHING

EXAMPLE HE IS STUDYING BECAUSE HE WANTS TO PASS HIS EXAMS.
