NEGATIVE SENTENCES

To make negative sentences you use the auxiliary verb "didn't" and the verb in infinitive. (Para hacer oraciones negativas se usa el verbo auxiliar "didn't" y el verbo en infinitivo)

Examples: Yesterday, I didn't go to the supermarket. (Ayer, no fui al supermercado)

As you see in the example, after the subject "I" you write "didn't + infinitive verb". The verb doesn't go in the simple past because of the auxiliary verb. (Como verán en el ejemplo, después del sujeto "Yo" se escribe "didn't + verbo en infinitivo". El verbo no va en pasado por el auxiliar.)
