| 2) SIMPLE PAST | : WAS/ WERE + Vpast participle |
| 3) PRESENT CONTINUOUS | : IS/ARE BEING + Vpast participle |
| 4) PRESENT PERFECT | : HAS/HAVE BEEN + Vpast participle |
| 5) MODAL VERBS | : MODAL + BE + Vpast participle |
