

Focus

Have got/has got is used to speak about possession.

Pattern:

Positive

Subject	have got/has got	object
I/you/we/they	have got	a headache.
She/he/it	has got	a big house.

Negative

Subject	haven't got/hasn't got	object
I/you/we/they	haven't got	a headache.
She/he/it	hasn't got	a big house.

Interrogative

Have/Has	subject	got	object
Have	I/you/we/they	got	a headache?
Has	she/he/it		a big house?

Short answer:

Positive:	Negative:
Yes, I/you/we/they have.	No, I/you/we/they haven't.
Yes, she/he/it has.	No, she/he/it hasn't.

May = boleh/diizinkan

Contoh :

You may go = kamu boleh pergi

You may not go = kamu tidak boleh pergi

May I go ? = Bolehkah saya pergi?

Note:

May Not

May not is used to give a prohibition.

Example:

He has got a toothache.

He **may not** eat candy. (give a prohibition)
