U-TURNS

LEGAL U-TURNS:

- 1) A U-TURN IS TURNING YOUR VEHICLE AROUND IN THE _____ TO GO BACK THE WAY YOU CAME.
- 2) TO MAKE A _____, SIGNAL AND USE THE FAR LEFT LANE OR THE CENTER LEFT TURN LANE.
- 3) YOU MAY MAKE A LEGAL U-TURN:
 - ACROSS A _____ YELLOW LINE WHEN IT IS SAFE AND LEGAL.
 - IN A RESIDENTIAL _____:
 - IF THERE ARE NO VEHICLES APPROACHING YOU WITHIN 200 _____.
 - WHENEVER A TRAFFIC _____, LIGHT, OR TRAFFIC SIGNAL LIGHT PROTECTS YOU FROM APPROACHING VEHICLES.
 - AT AN INTERSECTION ON A GREEN TRAFFIC SIGNAL LIGHT OR GREEN ARROW, _____ A "NO U-TURN" SIGN IS POSTED.
 - ON A DIVIDED HIGHWAY, ONLY IF AN _____ IS PROVIDED IN THE CENTER DIVIDER.

ILLEGAL U-TURNS

NEVER MAKE A U-TURN:

- 1) AT OR ON A _____ CROSSING.
- 2) ON A DIVIDED HIGHWAY BY CROSSING A DIVIDING SECTION, CURB, STRIP OF LAND, OR TWO SETS OF DOUBLE _____ LINES.
- 3) WHERE YOU CANNOT SEE CLEARLY 200 FEET IN EACH DIRECTION BECAUSE OF A CURVE, HILL, _____, FOG, OR OTHER REASON.
- 4) WHERE A "NO U-TURN" SIGN IS _____.
- 5) WHEN _____ VEHICLES MAY HIT YOU.
- 6) ON A ONE-WAY _____.
- 7) IN FRONT OF A _____ STATION. NEVER USE A FIRE STATION DRIVEWAY TO TURN YOUR VEHICLE AROUND.
- 8) IN BUSINESS DISTRICTS. AREAS WITH _____, APARTMENTS, MULTIFAMILY HOUSING UNITS, AND PUBLIC BUILDINGS (EXCEPT SCHOOLS) ARE ALSO CONSIDERED TO BE BUSINESS DISTRICTS.
- 9) TURN ONLY AT AN INTERSECTION, UNLESS A SIGN _____ IT, OR WHERE OPENINGS ARE PROVIDED FOR TURNS.
