The verb **BE**

+

I am

You are

He, she, it is

We, you, they are

-

I am not = I'm not

You are not = you aren't

He, she, it is not = he, she, it isn't

We, you, they are not = aren't

?

Am I...?

Are you...?

Is he, she, it...?

Are we, you, they ...?

The verb **HAVE GOT**

+

I have got

You have got

He, she, it has got

We, you, they have got

-

I have not got = I haven't got

You have not got = I haven't got

He, she, it has not got = he, she, it hasn't got

We, you, they have not got = haven't got

?

Have I got ...?

Have you got...?

Has he, she, it got ...?

Have we, you, they got ...?
