

RELATIVE PRONOUNS

Relative pronouns introduce relative clauses that describes a noun or a pronoun. The most common relative pronouns are **who, whom, whose, which, that**. The relative pronoun we use depends on what we are referring to and the type of relative clause.

WHO	Used to people (subject)
WHOM	Used for people (object)
WHOSE	Used for possession
WHICH	Used for animales and objects
THAT	Used for people animals and things
