



CONDITIONALS

In English, there are different types of conditionals:

• Real Conditionals

✎ TYPE 0 → Facts and scientific truths

Present Simple + IF/WHEN + Present Simple

✎ TYPE 1 → Possible, likely future situations if the conditions happens

Present Simple + IF + WILL

• Unreal Conditionals

✎ TYPE 2 → Unlikely present or future situations

Past Simple + IF + WOULD/COULD/MIGHT

✎ TYPE 3 → Imaginary situations about the past, sometimes expressing regret

Past Perfect + IF + WOULD HAVE followed by a PAST PARTICIPLE
