Apollo 11 : Astronauts Neil Armstrong and Edwin Aldrin, Jr., become the first men to land on the Moon	1492	Vietnam War : Prolonged conflict between Communist forces of North Vietnam, backed by China and the USSR, and non-Communist forces of South Vietnam, backed by the United States.

Martin Luther King's "I Have a Dream" speech during the civil rights March on Washington, DC / President Kennedy is assassinated in Dallas, TX.	1620	
Congress adopts the Declaration of Independence	1775-1783	Christopher Columbus discovers the New World
President Trump decides to withdraw the U.S.A from the Paris Agreement dealing with greenhouse-gas-emission reduction	July 4 <sup>th</sup> , 1776	
Civil War between the North (the Union) and the South (the Confederacy - Mississippi, Florida, Alabama, Georgia and Louisiana) over the expansion of slavery into western states	1789	Slavery is prohibited (13 <sup>th</sup> Amendment) / Lincoln is assassinated
Hurricane Katrina in Mississippi and Louisiana; 80% of New Orleans is flooded	1803	American Revolution opposing the British and the 13 colonies
Prohibition : 18 <sup>th</sup> Amendment prohibiting the manufacture, sale and transportation of liquor	1830	Pilgrims flee from England to the New World on the Mayflower.
Nationwide protests break out after the killing of African-American George Floyd by police / The "Black Lives Matter" movement spreads	1838	
George Washington becomes the first American President	1848	World Trade Center and Pentagon terrorist attacks : 3,000 people die / Hunt for Bin Laden starts, Taliban Afghanistan is attacked
Shooting at Columbine High School : 14 students (including the 2 shooters) and one teacher die	1861-1865	"The Trail of Tears" : 4,000 Cherokee Indians die from starvation and disease
Indian Removal Act: it authorizes the forced removal of Native Americans living in the East to lands West of the Mississippi River	1865	Stock Market crash precipitates the Great Depression
	1919	US declares war on Japan after the attack of Pearl Harbor

	1929	Jamestown, the 1st permanent English settlement in America, is established in Virginia
	December 8 <sup>th</sup> , 1939	Louisiana Purchase : the Louisiana territory is bought to France for \$15M.
