

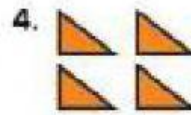

Write an addition sentence and a multiplication sentence to show equal rows.



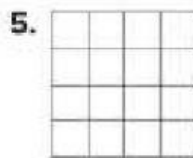
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Use the Commutative Property of Multiplication to find each missing number.
