Usamos **An** antes de los sonidos vocálicos (a, e, i, etc.) Ex. **He is an actor.**

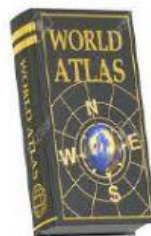
