Countable Nouns	Uncountable Nouns
<ul style="list-style-type: none">Can be count: <i>a car, a child, an apple.</i>Can take singular or plural form. <i>There is a book on the table.</i> <i>Those houses are very big.</i>Go with <i>a/an</i> in the singular form. Go with <i>some</i> in the plural form.Can be used along with: <i>some/any/many</i> in the plural form. <i>There are some pears.</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Cannot be counted: <i>Sugar, information, water.</i>Always take singular form <i>There is some water spilt on the floor.</i>Go with <i>some</i>.Can be used along with <i>some/any/much.</i> <i>There is some information about the weather.</i>
